

Collecting and Submitting Screwworm Samples

New Mexico-2025

Collection:

1. With forceps, gently remove larvae of different sizes from several sites of the wound (ensure samples are also removed from the deepest tissue of the wound).
2. Place larvae in a leak-proof container/vial, fully submerged in 70% alcohol (ethanol or isopropyl).
3. Label the vial(s) with animal ID, date/time of collection, location, and collector's name.
4. Seal the vial/container and place it in a sealable plastic bag. Place this bag into another sealable plastic bag.
